

Executive Summary

The girls are made aware of their rights by imparting lectures on laws and bylaws, counseling cells are arranged through renowned counselors and legal advisers. Number of girl students take part in cultural activities in youth festivals at university, inter university levels.

2.0 Scope of gender audit

The purpose of the gender audit is to ensure that the gender policy is followed and implemented in the college campus, all the departments, ladies hostel, canteen, administrative bodies and related areas. Based on gender equality the girls are always made to feel secure and free to perform their academic and extra curricular activities.

3.0 Objectives of gender audit

The Objectives of the gender audit can be summarized as follows:

- To examine and confirm whether there is gender balance in different areas and factors affecting the gender balance.
- To examine the policies of the college and thereby the implementation of the rules which can meet the interests of girls at large.
- To establish good gender balance in decision making.
- To make recommendations for bridging the gap if any.
- To promote gender equality in all aspects.
- To prevent and prohibit sexual harassment at the work place.

- To provide better facilities and amenities at the girls hostel.
- To make the girls aware of basic health and hygiene by arranging guest lectures and counselling sessions.
- To provide a platform for internal complaints which arise at the work and dwelling places.
- To provide platform for the girls in debating so as to render their views.

4.0 Methodology

It is an attempt to pursue gender audit to analyze, check and detect any gender bias in aspects of girls and women at the workplace and dwelling and also to eliminate the same so as to create a socially healthy community. A gender policy is followed in the campus, across all departments, administrative bodies and students. In order to meet the objectives, the gender audit carried out physical inspection, there was a review of relevant documentation, also discussions/interactions were conducted with the girls on the campus and ladies hostel.

- Physical inspection: The audit team conducted an inspection in the college The discipline committee is always on the lookout for good behavior and good environment for boys and girls to make the campus a better place for study and work.
- Review of documentation: To make an analysis of the gender policies, the documents and standards were studied and the relevant data was analysed.
- **Discussions/interactions:** The students including boys with more emphasis on girls were interviewed verbally for the purpose of gender bias and adopted policies.
- NAAC guidelines: The NAAC guidelines are followed.
- Best gender balance norms: The existing norms and regulations of government, legislation, semi-government bodies etc are taken into account.

5.0 Gender sensitive features in Shri Shivaji Mahavidyalaya, Barshi and related recommendations

With the view in mind of gender audit, based on the various methods of observations and analysis, gender sensitive features are observed in every corner of the system. Various aspects starting from the enrolment of students at the graduate level, category-wise admissions, ant ragging committee, internal complaints committee, sexual harassment prevention act, girls hostel, etc are discussed here.

5.1 Girls hostel

"A girl should know who and what she wants", the right place where a girl can be given the chance to blossom and conquer the world, at home and school. Girls' Hostel is one type of residential care service which provides out-of-home care for the youth either at school or at work. The objectives of Girls' Hostel are:

- to provide substitute care for the youth in a stable and group living environment to provide a residential programme with supervised living, guidance and supportive counseling services on residents' problems while undertaking education.
- to take care in the form of small group living within the hostel to facilitate individual contact, attention and closer relationship between residents in the hostels.
- to provide guidance and supportive counselling to the residents on their personal problem
- to provide social and recreational activities.
- to provide better food, health related amenities.
- to provide better energy resources like solar water heaters, LED sources etc.

Considering the qualitative performance of the college, the students from remote and rural places around Barshi in the surrounding vicinities, demanded special accommodative facility for girls. Aided by the UGC funds the college has a well built girls hostel which has an intake capacity of 300 students. Every room has 3 beds.

There is an independent mess for the girls. All measures of cleanliness are taken.

• Recommendations –

- There is need to increase the intake capacity of the girls taking into consideration the increase in the girls enrollment at graduation and post graduation level
- There is a need to increase the solar energy panels.
- Periodic energy audits need to be planned to have enough data on savings and contribution through use of solar energy.
- Need to shut down light during day time to save electricity.
- there is need to increase study room facility for the girls.

5.2 Gender balance in enrollment at graduation level

The enrolment of girls and boys at the graduation and post-graduation level is accomplished as per the guidelines of the government and UGC.

• Recommendations –

In the college, enrollment of students is done according to the norms of government and UGC guidelines. Various social categories are given priority so that girls are enrolled in that social community category. It is observed from the above tabulated data that for SC, ST, NT-A, NT-B, NT-C, NT-D categories the percentage of girls enrolled is averaged between 30-40 % which is comparatively low.

- Special emphasis can be given by creating social awareness, counseling to the girls as well as parents.
- International women's day is scheduled on 8th March, awareness programmes can be arranged for the importance of education of girls.
- teaching women and men explicitly and directly about gender equality issues involving families, men and boys, and helping girls and women address equality.
- concerns involving NGO's and local governing bodies.
- involving policy makers and educational leaders.
- ensuring that schools develop pedagogies that acknowledge and critically analyse how traditional, religious and familial cultures might support or undermine gender equality.

5.3. Prevention of Sexual harassment -

Our Constitution provide the fundamental rights of woman equality under articles 14 and 15, the right to life and to live with dignity under article 21, right to practice any profession or to carry any occupation, trade or business which also includes a right to a safe environment free from sexual harassment.

"The Sexual harassment of women at work place (Prevention, prohibition and redressal) Act", 22nd April 2013

As per the rules and regulations "Students Grievance Redressal Committee" is set up in the college under the chairmanship of Prin. Dr. A. B. Shaikh. The work of this committee involves counselling, research and extension. The committee conducts various programs such as counseling on self-defence, yoga, pre-marriage precautions, women empowerment, gender equality etc. An "Internal complaint Committee" is also set up. A complaint box is set up which maintains utmost confidentiality of any type of issue which is raised and which is to be resolved in tandem with the rules and regulations of violation of the article 5(d) of the

Sexual Harassment of Women at Work place (prevention, prohibition and redressal)

Act. The amendments and improvements suggested by the committee are fulfilled during the last five years basically -

- Independent study room for girls and boys.
- Strict discipline at the entrance and also moving places in the campus.
- Provided cycle facility for the girls separately.
- Provided separate staircase for the girls.
- The staff and the students wear collar identity cards so as to identify the college students and control outsiders to enter the premises.
- Security guards are posted at key points of the college premises.
- CCTV's are installed for round the clock surveillance.
- Provided karate training for girls.

Recommendations –

Lot of care is taken in the college to make it a socially secure and homely environment for the girls and female working staff. However a few measures can be improved.

- Separate resting arrangement for the ladies staff.

5.6. NCC for girls -

There is NCC unit which provides a suitable environment for taking a career in armed forces for the desiring girls. The girls are given training in every aspect and motivated in all walks of life. - Inequality can be reduced by taking balanced number of female members in various internal committees of the college so that there can be gender balance.
